Weekly Gatherings

I wrote last week about the unchanged Health Order from the NSW Government and the continuation of 4m2 physical distancing. It is in consideration of the ongoing nature of COVID 19 and the current Health Order that our weekly gatherings for Term 4 of 2020 are as follows.

Commencing next Sunday the 18th October, the **10:30am** gathering at Moss Vale will no longer be split over 2 Sundays but will rejoin together each Sunday meeting in the St John's building. Once we reach capacity in the St John's building the wardens will direct the remainder of our church family into the hall and the service will be streamed onto a large TV. We may need to readjust our gathering when the modernisation of the hall begins, however at the moment, the commencement or works date is uncertain.

We will also continue with the **8:30am** gathering at Moss Vale. This has been a wonderful amalgamation of our Bong Bong and 8am church families. I have witnessed many fruitful conversations and I have been encouraged by the unity we share in the gospel that has been evident by this single church gathering.

My prayer is that in time this joining together will also see fruit for the gospel in terms of men, women, and children coming to faith in Jesus, and will have a lasting impact on the spiritual health of our broader community.

In addition to the 8:30am and 10:30am gatherings at Moss Vale, the fortnightly 10am gathering of our **High Range** church family, as well as weekly gatherings at **Berrima** (alternating fortnightly 9:30am & 5:30pm) will continue unchanged.

Commencing from Tuesday 20th October, every Tuesday at 11am I will begin a new Prayer Book Service at **Bong Bong**. This will be particularly for those who haven't been able to, or have chosen not to gather on Sundays, however anyone from any of our churches are able to attend. Due to the 4m2 physical distancing requirement the Bong Bong building can only hold 14 people (plus the service leader and preacher) and so this gathering will also be ideal for those who are concerned about gathering in larger groups.

Brothers and sisters I'd like to thank you for your patience and understanding during this time. I have been wonderfully encouraged by your commitment to Jesus and your care for one another. Please continue to pray for myself and our Wardens as we navigate through 4th term and into 2021. Pray for our ministry leaders as they determine the best way forward for their groups and join me in praying that God will bring an end, by whatever means, to COVID.
